



# AIDS Walk New York 2013

A steady downpour of rain did not deter more than 30,000 people from participating in the 28th annual AIDS Walk New York in Central Park on Sunday, May 19. This year's walk raised \$5.5 million for GMHC and more than 40 other AIDS service organizations throughout the tri-state area.

AIDS Walk New York is the largest AIDS fundraising event in the world and has raised more than \$128 million for HIV programs and services. The theme of this year's AIDS Walk New York was "Community."
