



Ryan White CARE Act Turns 21

August 18, 2011

August 18 is the 21st anniversary of the Ryan White Comprehensive AIDS Resources Emergency (CARE) Act, the largest federally funded U.S. program for people living with HIV/AIDS. Named for the late Indiana teenager with AIDS whose advocacy brought information about the disease into the mainstream, the CARE Act currently funds support services for more than 500,000 low-income, underinsured and uninsured people with HIV/AIDS. In a statement, U.S. Representative Alcee L. Hastings (D-Fla.) emphasized the importance of maintaining full funding for the CARE Act and pledged to give the program his continuing support.
