



Four Women Allege NY Man Failed to Disclose HIV Status

A fourth woman has come forward in the case against an HIV-positive African-American man in Buffalo, New York, Buffalo News reports. Darryl Fortner, 20, has been charged with first-degree reckless endangerment for allegedly failing to disclose his HIV status to each of the four women before sex. The [Positive Justice Project](#) has criticized media coverage of the case and the underlying principle of criminalizing failure to disclose one's HIV status, stating that fear of prosecution will make people avoid HIV testing.
