



Supplies of Belly Fat-Reducing Egriftra Have Thinned Out

The biotechnology company Theratechnologies has announced a major shortage of its drug Egriftra (tesamorelin, for injection), which reduces HIV-related excess belly fat. The depleted stocks are a consequence, the company says, of “manufacturing delays and issues observed during the production of new batches of Egriftra.”

Consequently, the company has temporarily halted production of the drug. No estimates have been released as to when Egriftra manufacturing will be back underway. The company has stated that it is conducting an investigation as to the cause of this kerfuffle.
