



Study: HIV Meds Will Cost Global Fund Nearly \$2B Yearly

The Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria will need to spend between \$1.6 billion and \$1.9 billion per year to provide ongoing support to the 2.5 million people it already provides with antiretroviral (ARV) therapy, according to a study released at the XVIII International AIDS Conference in Vienna and reported by [aidsmap.com](#). The Global Fund plans to increase the number of people it provides with ARVs to 3.5 million by the end of 2011.
