Latino leaders across the U.S. launched the first **National Latino AIDS Awareness Day** October 15 to spice up HIV prevention and awareness among chicos and chicas...**Aid for AIDS**, a grassroots godsend that gives Americans' unused meds to HIVers in Latin America and the Caribbean, is \$100,000 richer thanks to a Ford Foundation grant...China's Henan Provincial Health Department deputy director **Ma Shiwen**, jailed in August for leaking classified AIDS cover-up memos from Henan's blood-collecting scandal, was released October 16...**Paul Volberding, MD**, UCSF vice-chair and cofounder of the world's first outpatient AIDS clinic, became chair of the HIV Medicine Association's board October 10.
