On July 1, New York City's **Gay Men's Health Crisis** and **AIDS Project Los Angeles** partnered to hatch the Institute for Gay Men's Health—a bicoastal scheme to develop and promote national wellness initiatives...**Abbott Laboratories** agreed July 16 to partially fund **AIDS Healthcare Foundation's** prevention, testing and treatment programs in the U.S. and Africa—helping settle an AHF lawsuit over Abbott's HIV-med Norvir price hike...On July 4, a federal judge dismissed former Maryland General Hospital lab worker **Kristin Turner's** lawsuit alleging that a blood-testing machine had infected her with HIV and hep C; Turner's workers' comp protects the hospital from litigation...*In memoriam*: Top Seattle AIDS doc **Stephen Tabet**, MD, 42, died suddenly July 6 of an unknown illness; Atlanta HIV doc **Eimear Kennedy**, MD, 50, died of breast cancer June 20.

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
