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“He’s dangled out of helicopters to save people,” said a senior official at a March 26 press conference, confirming Bush’s Surgeon General choice as Richard Carmona, MD, an Arizona trauma surgeon who won a Top Cop award for his role in a highway shootout.... Johns Hopkins radiologist Elias Zerhouni, MD, was tapped to head the NIH, a post vacant for two years. Carmona and Zerhouni are both said to have passed Bush’s Christian litmus test: anti-abortion (and stem-cell research), pro-abstinence....
