Since his July 1997 POZ cover story, HIV positive former boxer TOMMY MORRISON has been in and out of jail. In December, he went back in for—among other charges—cocaine possession and simultaneous possession of drugs and firearms. He's serving two years of a 10-year sentence (the rest was suspended) at a minimum-security Arkansas prison. Morrison, once an outspoken antimedics champion, had been on AIDS drugs in the past year, according to his lawyer, but recently stopped. While awaiting trial, he was twice transferred to a hospital because of dehydration and other undisclosed illnesses.
