



# Utah Bill to Demand HIV Testing of Alleged Rapists

A committee in the Utah House of Representatives unanimously approved a proposed bill to require alleged rapists to get tested for HIV if demanded by their alleged victims, *The Salt Lake Tribune* reports. The bill now moves to the full House. Proponents of the bill say it will spare many plaintiffs from having to go on a post-exposure prophylaxis regimen of HIV medications to prevent possible transmission of the virus. Currently, rapists in the state are tested for HIV only following a conviction.
