



ACTION ALERT: Urge the House to Pass 2026 Spending Bill to Fund HIV Programs

Also demand that your representative limit funding of the Department of Homeland Security. Here's how to call and what to say.

February 1, 2026 By Save HIV Funding

On Friday evening, January 30, the Senate passed a 5 bill Fiscal Year 2026 (FY2026) spending package that includes funding for global and domestic HIV programs! As a result of substantial pressure from constituents and advocacy groups nationwide, the White House, Senate Republican Leadership, and Senate Democrats agreed to limit the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) funding to two weeks. During this two-week period, the White House and Congress are expected to develop an agreement on DHS oversight and policy changes related to ICE and immigration enforcement.

The Senate bill must now go back to the House of Representatives for final passage, with a vote in the House maybe as early as Monday, February 2. We need your help now! Please to urge Representatives to:

Pass the final FY26 spending bill package that:

1. Fully funds access to health care and supports for people living with and vulnerable to HIV in the U.S. and globally.
2. Limits funding for the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) to only 2 weeks while leaders develop important guardrails and reforms for ICE and related immigration enforcement.
