



# Ali Forney Center Chelsea Drop-In Destroyed by Hurricane Sandy

Flooding from Hurricane Sandy has destroyed the daytime-only drop-in center for homeless LGBT youth run by the New York City-based Ali Forney Center, The Advocate reports. Located in the Chelsea neighborhood of Manhattan, the lease for the space was going to expire in January. The opening of a new 24-hour drop-in center in Harlem that was already going to open in a few months will proceed on schedule. The immediate concern is providing services—such as food, clothing, showers, medical care and HIV testing—to homeless LGBT youth until the new location is open.
