



Praise for \$5M HIV Test Initiative in Coachella Valley, California

Bill Clinton praised the Desert AIDS Project and the Desert Regional Medical Center for their current HIV testing initiative, The Desert Sun reports. The former president made his remarks during a private breakfast at the third annual Health Matters conference of the Clinton Foundation, which was held in La Quinta, California. Get Tested Coachella Valley is a three-year, \$5 million HIV testing initiative. Clinton said the program—a bilingual Spanish/English effort to test everyone in the valley for HIV through routine checkups, emergency room visits and mobile clinics—could be a model for others.
