This week's events mark the 34th year of Dining Out For Life. It kicks off the last Thursday of April, considered national Dining Out For Life day, but not all cities participate at that time. Nashville's fundraiser, for example, takes place this year on May 8, St. Louis's on June 13 and Milwaukee's on September 12.
