24 - President Ronald Reagan issues an executive order to establish a presidential commission on the HIV epidemic to “recommend measures that Federal, State, and local officials can take to (1) protect the public from contracting HIV; (2) assist in finding a cure for AIDS; and (3) care for those who already have the disease.” (1987)
