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15 – Act Now: End AIDS, a coalition of HIV organizations nationwide launches at the United States Conference on AIDS. (2016)

17-19 – Positive Women’s Network–USA holds Speak Up! in Fort Walton Beach, Florida, the first national leadership summit for women living with HIV. (2014)

25 - Tez Anderson launches Let's Kick ASS—AIDS Survivor Syndrome, a grassroots support group for those who survived the early days of the epidemic. (2013)

27 - National Gay Men's HIV/AIDS Awareness Day

30 – The World Health Organization recommends that all people living with HIV worldwide should receive antiretroviral treatment as soon as possible after diagnosis and that those at “substantial” risk for the virus should be offered pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP). (2015)

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
