



# Flat Funding for Global HIV/AIDS From Donor Nations in 2009

Funding by donor nations for global HIV/AIDS efforts was flat in 2009 as a result of the global economic crisis, according to a study from the Kaiser Family Foundation (KFF) and the Joint United Nations Programme on HIV/AIDS (UNAIDS). According to a KFF/UNAIDS statement, the Group of Eight nations, the European Commission and other donor governments gave \$7.6 billion in 2009 compared with \$7.7 billion in 2008. The United States remains the largest donor nation to HIV/AIDS, accounting for 58 percent of 2009 disbursements.
