The annual Picnic by Design fundraiser was a real showstopper this year, bringing in nearly \$60,000 for HIV/AIDS organizations across the country. Hosted by [DIFFA: Design Industries Foundation Fighting AIDS](#), the event tasked New York's top design talent with creating 23 picnic baskets based on Broadway themes and filled with inventive goodies—including dinnerware sets, pillows, blankets, champagne (and champagne flutes!) and, of course, Broadway tickets, autographed Playbills and backstage passes.

The reimagined picnic baskets were on display and auctioned off September 5 at Viacom Terrace

and Lounge. Located in the heart of Times Square, the venue provided the nearly 300 attendees with spectacular views of the Great White Way.

The real stars of the night were the imaginatively designed picnic baskets (and, of course, the funds they raised to fight AIDS). A few examples of baskets, with text taken directly from DIFFA descriptions:

Vanessa drew her inspiration from the 1961 film *Breakfast at Tiffany's*, featuring the iconic star Audrey Hepburn in the role of Holly Golightly, and the 2013 stage production starring Emilia Clarke. The classic storyline of the timeless film featuring Givenchy's little black dress and white pearls and Henry Mancini's score seemed the perfect inspiration for a picnic in Manhattan.

Basket includes: A vintage Tiffany & Co. sterling silver tag necklace, a vintage luggage 24-inch trolley suitcase by CO-Z, 2 Tiffany bone china paper cups, 2 champagne bottles, 2 Martina flutes, 2 boxes of Cracker Jacks, 2 Gibson Elite bone china plates, 2 Hampton Forge forks, 2 Breakfast at Tiffany's ticket pillows, a Tiffany Ribbon gift box blanket (51" X 60"), 2 napkins, assorted food items, a TYSILK cat and a \$50 Tiffany Blue Box Café gift card.

from Lip Service Napkins, and 4 pink and orange ombré placemats and 4 hashtag gold coasters from Kim Seybert. In addition, Ramy Cosmetics provided a makeup and brow-shaping gift certificate, as well as cosmetics, because everyone needs to look gorgeous—remember, on Wednesdays we wear pink! And, of course, the locker includes a \$300 gift certificate to see Mean Girls, as well as a \$200 gift certificate to dine at the Cafeteria just like The Plastics!

Basket includes: A Patricia Field/House of Field disco jacket (\$270 value) and accommodations for two for one night with a complimentary bottle of champagne and a show at Ian Schrager's Public Hotel (\$400 value). Public Arts is a cutting-edge progressive and avant-garde multimedia

performance space like no other. Afterward, take a Hornblower silent disco cruise for four (\$200 value). Take home a Donna Summer signed lithograph (\$200 value), a Jonathan Adler Full Dose tray and throw (\$200 value) and Ian Schrager's Studio 54 tell-all book (\$80). Basket includes: In addition to a copy of the original script, the scene is set with a vintage steamer trunk filled to the brim with classic Americana picnic ware. 10 original vintage playbills, two original ticket stubs, classic 1920s playing cards and a custom handwoven picnic wine caddy with six wine glasses make this a full service picnic adventure. If you and your picnic partner are up for some light reading, check out the Images of America: Broadway book included in this setting. And last but not least, excite your taste buds with a bottle of Stratus wine (\$75) from the first LEED-certified winery in the world. Put on your Sunday clothes and head over to Sardi's for a preshow dinner (\$200). Give my regards to Broadway!
