The first HIV and Islam conference will be held November 19 to 21 in Malaysia, according to a statement from the International HIV/AIDS Alliance, which supports community action on the pandemic in developing countries. In Malaysia, 70 percent of people with HIV are Muslims, and most of them contracted the virus by sharing needles.
