



About.com Selects Top 20 HIV/AIDS Charities for 2014

About.com, an online information and resource site, [has selected](#) its top 20 HIV/AIDS charities for 2014. The criteria included: spending at least 75 percent of their budgets on programs, raising \$100 from every \$15 spent fundraising, not holding more than three years of available assets in reserve, and operating with financial transparency.

[In 2013](#), the list was restricted to groups whose only mission was HIV/AIDS. This year the criteria for the list expanded to include groups whose missions have expanded, but nonetheless emerged from the early HIV/AIDS epidemic and continue to actively serve people living with the virus. As a result, six new groups are on the list.

Here are the 2014 groups in alphabetical order: Aaron Diamond AIDS Research Center; AIDS Foundation of Chicago (AFC); AIDS Foundation Houston; AIDS Project Los Angeles (APLA); AIDS United; American Foundation for Children with AIDS; amfAR, The Foundation for AIDS Research; Broadway Cares/Equity Fights AIDS (BC/EFA); Cascade AIDS Project; Desert AIDS Project; Elizabeth Glaser Pediatric AIDS Foundation (EGPAF); Elton John AIDS Foundation (EJAF); Gay Men's Health Crisis (GMHC); God's Love We Deliver (GLWD); International AIDS Vaccine Initiative (IAVI); Pangea Global AIDS Foundation; Project Inform; San Francisco AIDS Foundation (SFAF); Treatment Action Group (TAG); and Whitman-Walker Health (WWH).
