People living with HIV today have yesterday's clinical trial volunteers to thank for the highly effective, better tolerated and easier-to-take medications now available. POZ recently asked whether you've ever participated in a clinical trial or would consider it. Here are your responses.

Have you ever participated in a clinical trial or study?

55% - Yes

45% - No

How would you rate your overall experience in clinical trials or studies?

64% - Very positive

26% - Somewhat positive

7% - Somewhat negative

3% - Very negative

Have you ever tried to enroll in a clinical trial or study but were told you were ineligible?

35% - Yes

65% - No

Do you know where to find information on clinical trials or studies?

33% - Yes

67% - No

95% of readers say they would consider joining a clinical trial or study in the future.

86% say they would be more likely to join a clinical trial or study if it were for a cure.

The #1 reason for choosing to participate in a clinical trial is to help advance research.
