



Watch Broadway Dancers Bare It in Times Square to Fight HIV

Broadway theaters might have been dark the past year because of COVID-19, but the curtain has never gone down on the HIV fundraising efforts of Broadway Cares/Equity Fights AIDS. Although the Broadway hoofers haven’t been high-kicking it in person with live audiences, they’ve put their can-do attitude to work coming up with ingenious ways to raise funds.

Case in point is their annual Broadway Bares spectacular burlesque, a one-night-only extravaganza that’s typically held on a Sunday night toward the end of June to coincide with New York City’s pride festivities. Like last year, this year’s show will be broadcast virtually, but unlike 2020, the dancers are able to rehearse their showstopping finale together—it literally takes place in the streets of Times Square, and [PIX 11 TV was there to capture the action](#) (watch the clip below).

This year’s show, Broadway Bares: Twerk from Home, will be streamed 9 p.m. EST Sunday, June 20, on [BroadwayCares.org](#). You can view the show for free, but donations are encouraged.

“It fuels my heart to be able to dance with such a big group of people,” dancer Tomas Matos told PIX 11.

“I look forward to it,” added Nalina Mann Watkins, another dancer, noting that the fundraising efforts foster a wonderful sense of community among the many participants.

The rehearsal marked the first time many of the dancers had seen each other face to face since the pandemic.

The 2020 Broadway Bares was supposed to mark the show’s 30th anniversary. That milestone will

now be celebrated in 2022, when it will take place live once again. Last year's digital Broadway Bares, Zoomed In, raised \$596,504.

A number of other virtual fundraisers are coming up, such as auctions for the chance to play virtual card games with celebrities such as Lisa Kudrow and Jason Alexander.
