Can HIV-related shower selfies become the new ice bucket challenge? That's what Project Runway star Jack Mackenroth and global LGBT social app Moovz hope. They've launched a new social media campaign with the hashtag #weareALLclean with the goal of raising both HIV awareness and the funds to cure AIDS.

Money will go to Housing Works, a New York City-based organization that fights the dual epidemics of HIV and homelessness, not just in the Big Apple, but also across the nation and the world.

"I was inspired by the use of the word 'clean,' especially common in gay culture, to describe oneself as STI/STD-free. Indirectly this implies that HIV-positive people are somehow 'dirty,'" Mackenroth said in a press release on the Housing Works [fundraising page](#) for the campaign.
