As January ends, we're finally catching our breath from all the holiday festivities. As we look back on the whirlwind of activities, one of the highlights for us was the DIFFA Thanks For Giving Cocktail Party at the Herman Miller Showroom in Midtown Manhattan.

DIFFA--Design Industries Foundation Fighting AIDS--was celebrating the 17 HIV/AIDS organizations that received a total of \$225,000 in grants from DIFFA. These particular grantees are located in New York, New Jersey, North Carolina and Georgia; combined, they offer an amazing range of services that cater to the HIV community.

Representatives from most of the groups attended the event, which gave us a chance to catch up on the important work they're doing--that is, when we weren't sidetracked by drooling over all the furniture in the Herman Miller showroom. We were glad to hear that Bailey House, which offers housing for HIV-positive people in New York City, is finally rebuilding after the damage it suffered from Hurricane Sandy back in 2012.

And we were excited to learn that Planned Parenthood is even more active in HIV work and prevention, and that the Washington Heights CORNER Project is using social media as a way to provide a needle exchange program to those injection drug users more apt to pick up syringes using modern technology.
