



Gui Pi Tang, Bu Zhong Yi Qi Tang updates-- and STI/Treatment Breaks & Minimally Suppressive Therapy

One friend started on the alleged T-cell boosting Chinese formula, Bu Zhong Yi Qi Tang (Astragalus and Ginseng Decoction), one week ago today, I believe.
