Some HIV treatment research highlights to expect at IAS 2023

IAS 2023 will feature the latest science on long-acting therapy, biodegradable implants, treatment data among people who inject drugs, and much more! HIV treatment and co-morbidities scientific highlights will include:

- Results of an open-label study evaluating the pharmacokinetics, safety and efficacy of bictegravir/emtricitabine/tenofovir alafenamide (B/F/TAF) in virologically suppressed pregnant women living with HIV
- Findings from an effort to transform three short-acting HIV drugs – tenofovir, lamivudine and dolutegravir (TLD) – into a novel, long-acting triple therapy in a single injectable dosage
- Insights on a biodegradable, subcutaneous implant delivery platform that could treat HIV for up to six months in young children
- New evidence that post-treatment controllers exhibit distinct CD8+ T cell features >before and after ART interruption
- A global systematic review and meta-analysis quantifying HIV treatment outcomes among

people who inject drugs
