Over the past decade we have made amazing gains in the battle against HIV in women and girls. Between [2005 to 2014](#), the number of new diagnoses among women declined by 40%. Unfortunately Black Women and Latinas continue to be disproportionately impacted. At the end of 2014, Black Women were 61% and Latinas were 17% of all women living with HIV in the US.

NMAC is proud to stand with our partner and ally Planned Parenthood, a key provider of comprehensive health services for women. In addition to health care, Planned Parenthood also provides HIV/STI education, prevention, testing, and linkages to care. In 2014 alone, Planned Parenthood provided over 650,000 HIV tests. Increasingly, their centers are a source of comprehensive HIV prevention, including counseling and innovative prevention options like pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP).
