



# Social Media Bashes the GOP's New Health Care Plan (AHCA)

Democrats and even some Republicans agree: The GOP's American Health Care Act is a poor replacement for the Affordable Care Act.

It might've taken House Republican leaders—to quote House Ways and Means Committee Chairman Kevin Brady (R-Calif.)—"six long years of fighting, working and waiting" to begin the repeal of the Affordable Care Act (ACA, or Obamacare) in earnest with their proposed American Health Care Act (AHCA), but it seems to have taken not much more than six minutes after its announcement on Monday for the wave of criticism to begin to flood social media.

Today, two committees in the House of Representatives (the House Ways and Means Committee, which oversees taxes, and the House Energy and Commerce Committee, which oversees health issues) began negotiating amendments to the AHCA during mark-up sessions.

Although the bill has the endorsement of President Trump, conservative Republicans think the new plan looks too much like the ACA. Meanwhile, Democrats see it as rolling back coverage for millions of Americans and benefiting the wealthy. Republicans Senator Rand Paul of Kentucky (who derisively calls the bill "RyanCare" after Speaker of the House Paul Ryan) and Senator Mike Lee of Utah agree with Democrats that if passed, the bill is likely to raise premiums and lead to inferior health care and coverage (these conservative Republicans also object to the bill's extension of so-called entitlements).
